

How to add -s to the infinitive in Present Simple

Be careful with some words when using the 3rd person singular.

• verbs ending in a sibilant [s] [z] [ʃ] [ʒ] [ʧ] [ʤ] or verbs ending in -o preceded by a consonant
We add -es to the infinitive.
I watch → he watches
I pass → he passes
I go \rightarrow he goes
I do \rightarrow he does
• verbs ending in -y (lady – boy rule)
Mind the letter that stands before -y.
Vowel before -y: Add -s.
I play \rightarrow he plays
Consonant before -y: Change -y to -i. Then add -es.
I hurry → he hurries
